

Guidelines for submitting Minor Waiver Form MS-L

Minor Release and Waiver Form MS-L requires the signatures of both parents and guardians for a Minor Participant credential before obtaining an SCCA competition license or to be a worker in hot areas for club racing. The ages for this waiver is 16-17 and no one under the age of sixteen (16) will be issued this waiver. This form is referred to as the Parental Consent, Release and Waiver of Liability form, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement and Assumption of Risk Acknowledgment. This is only one form front and back, and is good for two (2) years.

- A program for licensed minor competitors and workers, 16 and 17 years old working in “**hot**” areas.
- Minor Waiver and Release form states that it is for all SCCA and SCCA Pro events during the current calendar year.
- Requires the authorization and signatures of both parents/guardians. Both signatures must be witnessed at the track by an SCCA official then forwarded to the National office before being allowed in hot areas , or may be witnessed by a notary public and sent to the National Office
- Only parents/guardians may authorize and sign the waiver. Friends, brothers/sisters, relatives etc. MAY NOT sign the waiver on behalf of the minor.
- MS-L form is available only at National Office or at www.scca.com. On the home page select *About SCCA* tab, then *Insurance*. This form must be printed in color.
- ORIGINAL DOCUMENT MUST BE SUBMITTED AND PROCESSED BY THE NATIONAL OFFICE BEFORE ATTENDING AN EVENT.
